The Trustees are allocating \$500,000 amongst consumer beneficiaries that are billed by The Lines Company Ltd. You receive this as a separate credit on your account issued by TLC, and your entitlement is based on a flat rate across all consumer beneficiaries. Another \$500,000 is allocated to customers of King Country Energy Ltd in the same distribution area and this entitlement is apportioned based upon the amounts billed between 1st February 2017 and 31st January 2018.
